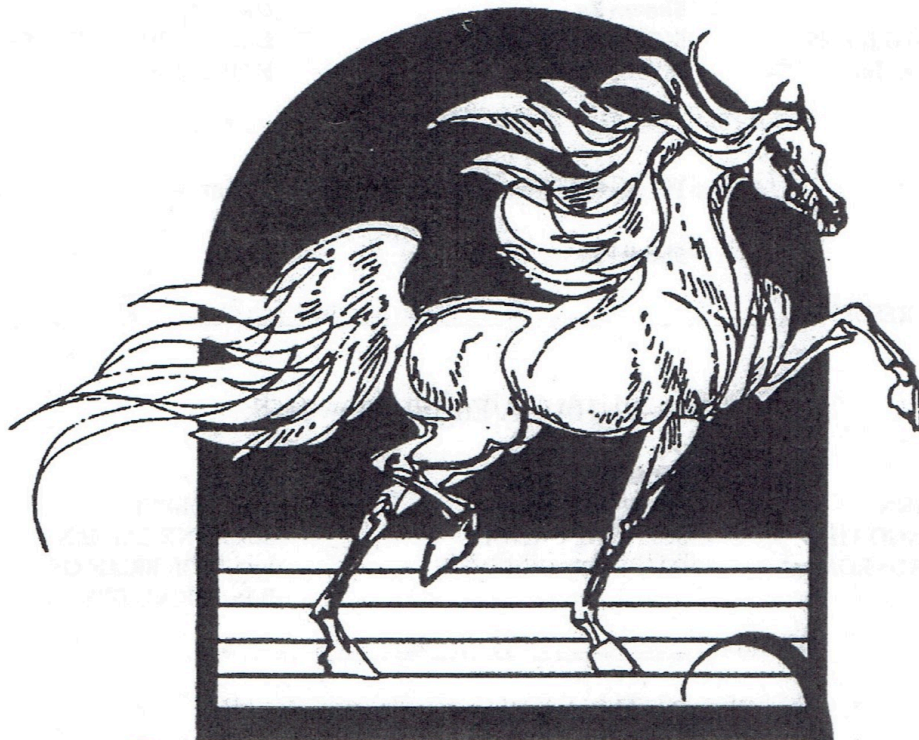

- Dressage classes will not be scheduled in class number order. Western and Classical classes may be mixed to efficiently accommodate as many riders as possible, i.e. all short court classes may run first, then all standard.
- All dressage classes are open to Arabians, Half-Arabians, and Anglo-Arabians.
- USDF/USEF 2023 tests will be used. 2022 Western Dressage tests will be used. The short court will be used for Classical Intro and Training Level and Western Intro and Basic.
- Dressage and SH In-Hand entries open April 21 and close May 14. Entries sent before 0001 April 21 will incur a 48-hr. penalty.

Entries *Open April 21 and Close May 14 (midnight)

**Dressage entries are limited, therefore for dressage classes, we must post an "Open" date. Entries for Western and Classical dressage are accepted in the order received by email or postmark. When time is full, a wait list will be established and used to fill times which may become available. Dressage entries sent prior to April 21 will incur a 48 hour penalty for acceptance.*

OFFICE HOURS: Wednesday, June 3 from 12 Noon – 9 PM and Thursday, June 4 through Sunday, June 7 from 7:30 AM until 15 minutes after the last class. The office may be closed during lunch and dinner breaks and will reopen 30 minutes before the start of the next session.

MOVE-IN is June 3 beginning at 8:00 AM. Early arrival is charged at the rate of \$30 per horse. Contact Joan if you are planning to arrive early or leave late.

ENTRIES must be submitted on the official entry form and be postmarked no later than May 14, 2026. Post entries will be accepted after the closing date at the post entry rate. Entries must be paid in full when submitting your entry; postdated checks will not be accepted. Open checks sent with entries will be filled in and cashed for the amount owed. An open check may be left in the show office when checking in to cover post entries and other incidentals. The secretary reserves the right to finalize open checks. Entries will not be accepted without payment.

ENTRY PAYMENT: is due at the time of entry. Entries will not be processed until payment is received. If payment is received after the close date, the entry will be considered a post entry and fees applied accordingly. Payment may be made via PayPal or by mailing a check to the entry secretary at the address on the entry form. If using PayPal, pay the appropriate amount on the PayPal entry form line using the links. It adds 4% to your total due.

FARM AND BUSINESS NAMES can be used only if it is the owner appearing on the horse's registration papers. In that case, the farm or business must be a business member of AHA and a copy of that card enclosed with the entry.

REFUND POLICY: Management agrees to refund entry and stabling fees on any horse or person not fit to show provided written notice is given on or before May 14, 2026. After May 14, 2026 and prior to Wednesday, June 3rd at 8 pm, withdrawal must be accompanied by a Veterinarian or Doctor certificate. In such cases, a refund of class entry fees will be given less the \$35 office fee per horse.

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES: The Region 5 AHA Board has directed that entries must be refused from anyone that has an outstanding obligation to a Region 5 affiliated club, show or contracted service. Management reserves the right to hold classes conditionally, or cancel entries of any contestant, as stated in AHA Rules. Show management reserves the right to reject any entry if it seems to be in the best interest of the show. The show committee reserves the right to remove any owner, groom, rider, trainer, manager, coach or driver groom (header), horse or rider from the show who has shown an objectionable attitude or behavior towards its management, or previous unsportsmanlike behavior, without being liable for compensation or damages.

POST ENTRIES will be accepted up to the end of the session prior to the class you wish to enter. To ensure correct reporting of results, please complete rider change & scratch forms before the respective class session.

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULEBOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. THE USEF RULE BOOK IS AVAILABLE AT WWW.USEF.ORG

ABBREVIATIONS: ATR Amateur to Ride AAOTR Adult Amateur Owner to Ride ATD Amateur to Drive JTR Junior to Ride AOTH Amateur Owner to Handle JOTR Junior Owner to Ride AOTR Amateur Owner to Ride JTH Junior to Handle.

ABUSE, CRUELTY, CONDUCT: All AHA and USEF rules regarding abuse, cruelty and conduct will be strictly enforced.

AATR SELECT, CHOICE & ELITE, AND JTR SELECT CLASSES:

Riders will be allowed to "level up" at this show. A rider may enter their level (see your level at www.arabianhorses.org) and a level up from that. For example, a Select rider in Western could also enter the Elite class. Riders may also enter the AAOTR class if they meet the USEF owner definition. Juniors, who are Select riders, may enter JTR Select classes as well as JTR and, if owners by USEF definition the JOTR.

ADMISSION TO THE ARENA: No person may enter the space set aside for the judging or hold any communication with the judge or examining veterinarian without permission of the steward or show management, who will arrange an appointment with the judge at the proper place and time. Failure to comply with this request could result in disqualification from subsequent classes and forfeiture of all entries, prize money, trophies and ribbons.

AGE OF HORSE AND RIDER: For horse show purposes a horse is considered to be 1 year of age on the first day of January following actual foaling date. A junior horse is 5 years old and under. Junior exhibitors are those who have not reached their 19th birthday by Dec 1 of the previous year. Junior exhibitors are considered amateurs and do not need amateur certification.

AMATEUR STATUS: By signing our entry form for this AHA Value Show, the amateur is attesting that he/she is an amateur by USEF definition.

ARENAS: Arena footing is sandy loam or sand. Measurements are: Main arena—120' x 248', covered warm up—100' x 200', front sand ring—128' x 254', NE sand ring—130' x 200', sand ring between barns 105 and 106—73' x 164', as well as several sand lunge rings.

AWARDS: Junior exhibitor classes will be awarded ribbons to eight places. All other classes will have ribbons to six places.

BIKES, MOPEDS AND ROLLERBLADES: Close calls between children, cars and horses have caused concerns. Please keep in mind this is a horse show facility, not a playground. Please supervise children when they are riding bikes and leave rollerblades at home. HACW and the EEP will not be responsible for injuries or damage caused by such activities.

BREEDING/IN-HAND SCORING SYSTEM: These classes will be judged on the AHA comparative system. Refer to AHA Comp 815. The AHA score sheet will be used for Performance Halter and Sport Horse in Hand.

CHANGE OF HANDLER/RIDER: It is the obligation of the exhibitor to notify the show office of any change in rider, driver, handler or cancellation of entry.

CLASS CONFLICTS: Exhibitors are cautioned against entering the same horse in successive classes. Due to full schedules, we will try to assist you in working through the schedule. No refunds will be given for class conflicts.

CLASS SIZE: Three entries constitute a class. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes that have not filled, to accept entries for unfilled classes at regular entry fees, and to reject an entry if in the best interest of the show.

DISCIPLINE: Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, trainer, groom, or rider will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The show committee reserves the right to remove a horse, owner, rider or groom from the show without being liable for compensation or damages. It is a violation of our rules to commit any act or make remarks during the show that are considered offensive or made with the intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging, and exhibitors may be barred from the show for this offense.

DOGS: Dogs are allowed on leashes and must be crated in the barns, barns or arenas. Owners will be asked to remove problem dogs from the grounds.

FARRIER: Will be on the grounds starting Wednesday June 4, and will accept clients on a CASH ONLY BASIS.

FEED: Feed is available from a number of area retailers.

FOOD: Food and beverages will be available from concessions during show hours.

LUNGEING: Lunging arenas will be provided, and will be marked. Lunging is not allowed in the main ring, the covered outdoor ring, the front sand ring, or the northeast sand ring.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

OFFICE: Located in the north corner of the main arena. The show office phone is (360) 805-6711.

PARKING: Parking is not allowed in the fenced fairgrounds area. Trucks and trailers must be removed immediately after unloading. Only emergency vehicles, vet and farrier will be allowed in the barn area. A fire lane must be maintained at all times.

PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES: If you are disabled, please write a brief explanation of your disability and any special needs that you may have. Please include this with your entries.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: It is compulsory for all junior riders in hunter seat equitation classes, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials) / SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Show committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required.

RETURNED CHECKS: There will be a \$50 fee per incident for any check dishonored for any reason. It is the policy of this organization to pursue all avenues to make collection on checks.

RV PARKING: The fairgrounds will handle all RV reservations, except full hook ups. Full hook up reservations will be made through Joan Palelek, midsummerhorseshow@gmail.com You may reserve and pay for your RV spot by phoning 360-805-6706 beginning **May 5**. Please have the length of your trailer/RV and if you have a tip-out. See Show Fees section for details and pricing. Please park only in your assigned space.

SPORT HORSE IN HAND: Classes will be run in the order in the prize list and horses will show in numerical order unless a handler has more than one horse in the class. Every attempt will be made to schedule to avoid conflict between rings. If there is still a conflict, let us know asap so we can work to resolve it.

STALLIONS: Arabian stallions may be shown by ladies and junior exhibitors in any class in this show except showmanship, lead line and walk-trot. Half Arabian and Anglo Arabian stallions registered with AHA or which have been issued an AHA Certificate of Registration issued by the Canadian Partbred Arabian Register are permitted to compete in AHA performance classes for Half Arabian and Anglo Arabian horses.

TRAIL SCHOOLING: Schooling on the trail course will be held Wednesday evening from 6:30 PM to 8:30 PM. Pay \$10 on your entry form. One round per horse until all who wish to go have gone.

STABLING AND ARRIVAL INFORMATION

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE: Stall fees are for arrivals Wednesday June 3, at 8 AM and departures completed on Sunday, June 7. Exhibitors may set up and bed stalls in assigned stabling areas on Tuesday, June 2 at no extra charge. Horses may not be brought in until Wednesday at 8 AM. Early arrival of horses is available by contacting show manager, Joan Palelek, 206-972-2163, to allow the fairgrounds to open the appropriate stalls. Early arrival is \$30 per day per horse stall.

BEDDING will be supplied by show management. A \$65 shavings and shavings removal fee will be charged per horse. This procedure is more cost effective as opposed to purchasing bagged shavings. Day Stall Fee is \$40 per day. Please indicate which night(s).

FIRE MARSHALL RULES: By order of the Fire Marshall, all aisles between stalls must remain open. All materials used for decorative purposes must be treated with flame retardant; this includes stall drapes, even those made of cordura. Please be prepared to present evidence of this to the Snohomish County Fire Department. The Fire Marshall will inspect the show grounds. Authorized electrical appliances for grooming purposes may be used. The electrical system may not be altered or tampered with, under any circumstances. If electrical cords are used, they must be of the heavy duty, outdoor type. **SMOKING IS NOT ALLOWED IN THE ARENAS OR BARN AREAS.** Shavings may not be used in aisles or barn walkways as they are a fire hazard.

SHARPS CONTAINERS have been placed throughout the barns. Please use them. Competition management will fine any individuals \$200 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

STABLING ASSIGNMENTS: One stall per horse, except mares with foals. Stall assignment made upon consideration of sponsorships, volunteer status, and continued support in exhibiting at our competition. No stabling changes without consent of barn manager. The decision of management is final. Exhibitors wishing to be stabled together must make note of it on the line provided on the entry form.

If you have special requests or considerations, please submit them with your entry. All requests will be considered, but no promises are implied. Stabling assignments can be viewed online at www.hacw.org on Monday, June 2.

STALL CONSTRUCTION: Wood/metal with wood/metal dividers. Half or full doors.

STALL AND BARN DAMAGE: Stalls may not be structurally altered in any way. This means no removal of fronts or tears down of sides to make larger areas. Do not put nails, screws or other types of hole producing devices into stall walls. The use of staples, tacks or tape to attach decorations to walls, buildings, stalls, etc. is prohibited. Horse hooves are not to be painted on unprotected barn floor and aisles. Exhibitors are financially responsible for any damage to stalls or barns and will be charged accordingly. Barns and stalls will be inspected for damage and alterations.

STALL CLEANING: The past few years, our facility contract has made the show responsible for cleaning stalls after the show and we build the cost into the cost of the stall. Last year, a Snohomish County 4-H club was hired to do the work. They have agreed to do the job again but let us know that many stalls were left with large amounts of dirty, wet shavings. It appears instead of cleaning daily, fresh shavings were added to the top every day, leaving large amounts of dirty, strong ammonia smelling shavings. This unfairly exposed the 4 H'ers to an unsafe breathing environment in a hot, enclosed area. Please clean your stalls daily and use fewer shavings to help us reduce the cost of stalls, shavings, cleaning and removal from the fairgrounds. We realize more shavings are used when supplied bulk. We are hopeful we can continue providing bulk shavings and still have a group willing to clean stalls. This year, we will again receive a list of those who leave excessive amounts of dirty, wet shavings and will add a \$30 cleaning charge to the account of the horse owner. Show management will determine if stalls have been over-bedded. Stalls are not to be used as dog kennels and will be charged for cleaning.

AWWA RANCH DISCIPLINED RAIL PLEASURE

The AWWA is proud to introduce a new Ranch class to serve the needs of an expanding exhibitor base. Entries will be shown and judged in accordance to the Ranch Rail Appointments and Conduct (AR242) as set forth in the Arabian Division of the USEF Rule Book. The Class Procedure for Ranch Discipline Rail Pleasure is noted below.

CLASS PROCEDURE:

The purpose of the AWWA Ranch Disciplined Rail Pleasure class is to show the ability of a well-trained Ranch Horse to be used as a work partner and companion. Horse should be willingly guided with smooth transitions and quality movements.

Judging shall be based on the best overall ranch disciplined rail performance. The class is not a game, nor a fault and out elimination class. Horses must not be over-worked. Safety of horse and rider are of first- priority.

1. Each horse enters the arena individually at the trot proceeding up centerline. At marker, exhibitors turn left and proceed down the long wall at an extended trot riding past the entry gate. Once past the gate each exhibitor will transition to the walk and find a place along the right-hand long wall to stand quietly as each exhibitor enters the arena.

2. When all exhibitors have performed the individual entry maneuver the call judge will work horses on the rail as a group at the walk, trot, and lope both directions of the ring. An extension of any gait may be called.

3. Exhibitors will be asked to perform additional work. Work may include, but it not limited to:

- a. Hand gallop
- b. Flying or Simple change of lead
- c. Halt & stand quietly on rail
- d. Side pass either to left or right
- e. Turn on hind quarters
- f. Turn on forehand
- g. Starting into lope from a halt
- h. Extension of any gait

Upon completion of rail work, horses will be lined-up side-by-side in center of arena. Individually, exhibitors will ride forward from line, turn a 360 in either direction, and then back into the original place in line.

The AWWA Ranch Discipline Rail Pleasure class will be offered at the 2026 Youth/Mid-Summer Nationals show in Oklahoma City, OK.

Horses nominated to the AWWA Incentive Fund will receive bonus prize money.

AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION

This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, leasee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.

I AGREE for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns **to release** AHA, the Competition, the facilities leased by the Competition and the owner(s) of the facilities, and all of their respective officers, officials, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, affiliated organizations and insurers (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and **all claims for damage, loss, or injury to myself, other persons, horses or other property belonging to me to the fullest extent** permitted by law that arises out of or relates in any way to the Competition and my participation in the Competition **INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DAMAGES, LOSS, OR INJURY RESULTING FROM ANY ACTS, FAILURE TO ACT, NEGLIGENCE OR NEGLECT OF OTHER ENTRANTS, THE RELEASED PARTIES, THEIR CONTRACTORS OR INVITEES**, as well as for theft, vandalism, fire, other casualty damage, or damage arising out of any defects in the premises.
